irst, each player is dealt four hole cards instead&#127773; of two. The betting  
rounds and layout of community cards are identical. At showdown, each player&#39  
&lt;p&gt;s hand is the best&#127773; five-card hand made from exactly three of the five  
cards on the board, plus exactly two of the player&#39;s own&#127773; cards. Unl  
ike Texas hold &#39;em, a player cannot play four or five of the cards on the bo  
ard with fewer&#127773; than two of their own (nor can a player play three or fo) Tj T\* BT

&lt;p&gt;A showdown&#127773; in Omaha hi-low split. Player on the left wins the  
low-hand half with the nut low A-2-3-4-5, player on the&#127773; right wins the  
high-hand half with a full house 5-5-5-J-J&lt;/p&gt;  
&lt;p&gt;Straights and flushes are ignored when judging low hands. Low hand&#127  
773; ranks from best to worst: 5-4-3-2-A (the wheel), 6-4-3-2-A, 6-5-3-2-A, 6-5-  
4-2-A, ..., 8-7-6-5-4. Low hands can thus be read as&#127773; numbers between 54  
,321 and 87,654 (with the exception of any number that has a pair, i.e. 54,322).

The lowest number&#127773; that any player can make, while ordered from high ca  
rd to low, is the best possible low hand in play.&#127773; For example: 2 3 £ 5 ¥  
6 ¥ 7 ¥ wins over A 2 £ 3 ¥ 4 £ 8 [7]&lt;/p&gt;
